## PRIMARY ELECTION SAMPLE BALLOTS ARRIVING SHORTLY

**Indian River County, FL** – Indian River voter households should be on the lookout for their Primary Election sample ballot arriving in the mail in the coming days. The sample ballot contains the candidates for the Primary Election and important election information that will help voters prepare to cast their ballot.

For this upcoming August 26<sup>th</sup> election, please remember that Florida is a closed primary state. Voters may only vote for candidates of the party for which they are registered in order to elect their party's nominee for the General Election. All voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote for nonpartisan races, such as school board candidates and judges.

For the upcoming Primary Election there are three main ballot styles: one for registered Republicans, one for registered Democrats, and one for all other voters who are registered as no party affiliation or with a minor political party. Please note, only one sample ballot will be mailed per household and all three ballots styles are listed on the sample ballot.
