Dolby ←</p> <hr/> <p><b>NO.1 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</b> <b>ARTICLE X, SECTION 29</b></p> <p><b>Rights of Electricity Consumers Regarding Solar Energy Choice</b></p> <p>This amendment establishes a right under Florida's constitution for consumers to own or lease solar equipment installed on their property to generate electricity for their own use. State and local governments shall retain their abilities to protect consumer rights and public health, safety and welfare, and to ensure that consumers who do not choose to install solar are not required to subsidize the costs of backup power and electric grid access to those who do.</p> <p>The amendment is not expected to result in an increase or decrease in any revenues or costs to state and local government.</p> <p>YES ←</p> <p>NO ←</p> <hr/> <p><b>NO.2 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</b> <b>ARTICLE X, SECTION 29</b></p> <p><b>Use of Marijuana for Debilitating Medical Conditions</b></p> <p>Allows medical use of marijuana for individuals with debilitating medical conditions as determined by a licensed Florida physician. Allows caregivers to assist patients' medical use of marijuana. The Department of Health shall register and regulate centers that produce and distribute marijuana for medical purposes and shall issue identification cards to patients and caregivers. Applies only to Florida law. Does not immunize violations of federal law or any non-medical use, possession or production of marijuana.</p> <p>Increased costs from this amendment to state and local governments cannot be determined. There will be additional regulatory costs and enforcement activities associated with the production, sale, use and possession of medical marijuana. Fees may offset some of the regulatory costs. Sales tax will likely apply to most purchases, resulting in a substantial increase in state and local government revenues that cannot be determined precisely. The impact on property tax revenues cannot be determined.</p> <p>YES ←</p> <p>NO ←</p>	<p><b>NO.3 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</b> <b>ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6</b> <b>ARTICLE XII</b></p> <p><b>Tax Exemption for Totally and Permanently Disabled First Responders</b></p> <p>Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to authorize a first responder, who is totally and permanently disabled as a result of injuries sustained in the line of duty, to receive relief from ad valorem taxes assessed on homestead property, if authorized by general law. If approved by voters, the amendment takes effect January 1, 2017.</p> <p>YES ←</p> <p>NO ←</p> <hr/> <p><b>NO.5 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</b> <b>ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6</b> <b>ARTICLE XII</b></p> <p><b>Homestead Tax Exemption for Certain Senior, Low-Income, Long-Term Residents; Determination of Just Value</b></p> <p>Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to revise the homestead tax exemption that may be granted by counties or municipalities for property with just value less than \$250,000 owned by certain senior, low-income, long-term residents to specify that just value is determined in the first tax year the owner applies and is eligible for the exemption. The amendment takes effect January 1, 2017, and applies retroactively to exemptions granted before January 1, 2017.</p> <p>YES ←</p> <p>NO ←</p> <hr/> <p><b>Indian River County, Florida</b> <b>One Cent Sales Tax Extension</b></p> <p>Shall the duration of the one-cent sales surtax levied in Indian River County be extended an additional fifteen years from December 31, 2019, its currently scheduled expiration date, to December 31, 2034, to finance, plan, and construct infrastructure including roads, bridges, jail expansion, libraries, fire/paramedic stations, stormwater improvements, recreation facilities, county administration buildings, closure of landfills, and any other county and municipality infrastructure projects allowed by law?</p> <p>FOR the extension of the one-cent sales tax. ←</p> <p>AGAINST the extension of the one-cent sales tax. ←</p> <hr/> <p><b>CITY OF SEBASTIAN, FLORIDA</b> <b>CHARTER AMENDMENT</b></p> <p>You are eligible to vote in the City of Sebastian Election if you live in one of the following precincts: 7,8,9,10.</p> <p><b>Compensation and Expenses for Mayor and City Council Members</b></p> <p>Shall Section 2.05 of the Charter be amended as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>to increase the compensation for the Mayor from \$450.00 to \$750.00 a month and to increase the compensation for the Vice-Mayor and City Council Members from \$300.00 to \$600.00 a month, and</li> <li>to require that any payments for expenses be limited to reimbursement of actual expenses incurred?</li> </ul> <p>YES for Approval ←</p> <p>NO for Rejection ←</p>
