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Election Day Reminders February 26 City of Vero Beach Special Municipal Election

Indian River County, FL – Below is all the information voters should know before heading to the polls on Tuesday, February 26 for the City of Vero Beach Special Municipal Election.

- Election Day polls are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. You must vote at your assigned polling place on Election Day.
- Only voters residing within the Vero Beach city limits will be eligible to vote in this election.
- To verify your polling location, visit VoteIndianRiver.com and click "Find My Precinct" or call 226-3440.
- Voters must present current and valid, photo and signature ID when voting, such as a Florida Driver's License. If voters do not present proper ID, they may vote a provisional ballot.
- Voters who have moved into Indian River County from another Florida county should report their new address to the Supervisor's office before Tuesday, February 26 to expedite the voting process. Address changes within Florida can be made on Election Day, but may cause slight voting delays while the voter completes the necessary paperwork.
- Voter turnout statistics are also available prior to and throughout Election Day at VoteIndianRiver.com. Select the icon, 2019 City of Vero Beach Special Election Turnout, to view a summary of vote-by-mail and Election Day turnout. Statistics may be filtered by party, date, or precinct.
- Election results will air on cable channel 13 in Vero Beach and on the Indian River County Government cable channel 27.
- Up-to-the-minute election night reporting will also be available at VoteIndianRiver.com. Simply click the Live Election Results Button. Results will be updated periodically throughout the evening until all precincts are counted. For the most up-to-date results, remember to "refresh" the webpage.

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
