Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for August 28 Primary Election

Indian River County, FL – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections has mailed 417 ballots to absent military and overseas voters on Friday, July 13th for the August 28, 2018 Primary Election. Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States. State law requires uniformed and overseas citizens ballots be mailed at least 45 days before early voting begins.

A ballot mailing to approximately 12,560 domestic voters is tentatively scheduled for July 24. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Indian River County. Domestic ballots are required to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election.
