VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS EN ROUTE FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Indian River County, FL- – City of Sebastian and the City of Vero Beach voters who have a vote-by-mail request on file should expect to receive their vote-by-mail ballot in the next few days. On Thursday, September 26, 2019, the Supervisor of Elections office sent an initial mailing of 6,012 ballots to domestic, military, and overseas voters for the November 5th Municipal Elections.

The deadline to request a vote-by-mail ballot for the November 5th Municipal Elections is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 26, 2019. After October 26th, voters may pick up a vote-by-mail ballot at the Elections Office, located at 4375 43rd Avenue in Vero Beach. On Election Day, voters must vote at their assigned voting precinct.

All voted mail ballots must be received by the Elections Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. To track the status of your mail ballot, visit VoteIndianRiver.com and click the “Track Your Vote-By-Mail Ballot” icon on the homepage, input the required information, then click “Show My Mail Ballot Information”.
