POSSIBLE MANUAL RECOUNT

Indian River County, FL – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections office is awaiting word from the Secretary of State regarding a manual recount for several races on the 2018 General Election ballot. If the order for a recount is issued by the Secretary of State before 8:30 a.m. on Friday, November 16th, the Indian River County Supervisor of Elections will be conducting a manual recount on Friday, November 16th beginning at 8:30 a.m.

A manual recount is ordered by the Secretary of State per Florida Statute 102.166, which states if the second set of unofficial returns indicates that a candidate for any office was defeated by one-quarter of a percent or less of the votes cast for such office, a manual recount of the overvotes and undervotes cast for such office shall be ordered.

The public and press may observe the manual recount, which will be held at the Supervisor of Elections office at 4375 43rd Avenue, Vero Beach.
