

#### FLORIDA RUNS CLOSED PRIMARY ELECTIONS

In Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election, you may vote for candidates only of the party for which you are registered. For example, registered Democrats will receive a Democratic primary ballot. Registered Republicans will receive a Republican primary ballot. Voters, who are registered with a minor party or no party affiliation, are not eligible to vote in partisan races.




Your Voter's Signature?

There are three ways to vote

#### 1. Mail Ballot

By Florida law any registered voter can vote using a mail ballot.

- A mail ballot request may be made in person, by mail, by e-mail, online via our website voteindianriver.com, or by telephone. One request can cover a specific election or all elections through the next two General Elections.
- *Wednesday, March 9, 2016* is the last day to request a ballot to be mailed to you for the March 15<sup>th</sup> Election.
