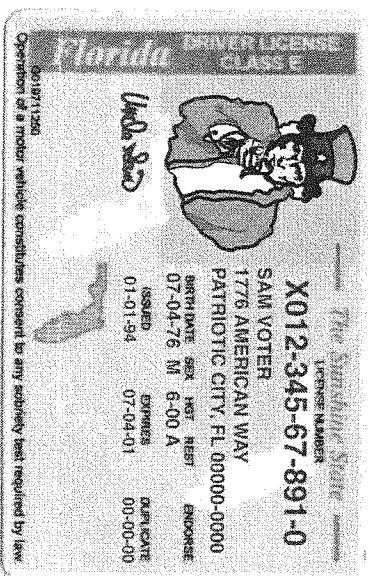


PHOTO ID REQUESTED AT POLLING PLACE

State law requires you to present a photo and signature ID when you come to the polling place to vote. If you do not have a photo and signature ID, you will be allowed to vote after completing an affidavit. However, it will take you longer to be processed to vote.

It is a **felony** to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside. If your address has changed, please contact the Elections Office **BEFORE** October 3rd. Polling place locations are found on the back of your voter I.D. card.
