This sample ballot may be taken to the polls to use as a reference.

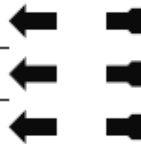

Did you know?

By Florida law any registered voter can vote using an absentee ballot.

- Absentee ballot requests may be made in person, by mail, by e-mail, by phone or at VoteIndianRiver.com. Request a specific election or all elections through the next two General elections.
- *Wednesday, March 4, 2015* is the last day to request absentee ballots by mail.

It is a **felony** to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside. Please call the Elections Office if your address has changed.



Please have your current and valid, photo and signature ID ready.

Some forms of acceptable ID include: FL Driver's License, FL ID, Passport, Student ID.

WHERE: Florida Voter Registration Application forms are available at all government offices, public assistance offices, libraries and upon request by calling or e-mailing our office or visiting our website.

HOW: Use a Florida Voter Registration Application form completing all required blocks per instructions. **WHEN:** At any point there is a significant change in your signature or identifying "mark".
