## FLORIDA RUNS CLOSED PRIMARY ELECTIONS

In Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election, you may vote for candidates only of the party for which you are registered. For example, registered Democrats will receive a Democratic primary ballot. Registered Republicans will receive a Republican primary ballot. Voters, who are registered with a minor party or no party affiliation, are not eligible to vote in partisan races.

## Did you know?

There are three ways to vote

### 1. Mail Ballot

By Florida law any registered voter  
can vote using a mail ballot.

- A mail ballot request may be made in  
person, by mail, by e-mail, online via  
our website [voteindianriver.com](http://voteindianriver.com), or by  
telephone. One request can cover a  
specific election or all elections through  
the next two General Elections.

- **Wednesday, March 9, 2016** is the last  
day to request a ballot to be mailed to you  
for the March 15<sup>th</sup> Election.

### 2. Early Voting

Early Voting is **March 5<sup>th</sup>**  
through **March 12<sup>th</sup>**  
7:30am - 4:00pm

## Need To Update

Your Voter's Signature?

**WHERE:** Florida Voter Registration Application forms are available  
at all government offices, public assistance offices, libraries and upon  
request by calling or e-mailing our office or visiting our website.

**HOW:** Use a Florida Voter Registration Application form completing  
all required blocks per instructions. **WHEN:** At any point there is a  
significant change in your signature or identifying "mark".

Election Day results will be posted on our website and can be viewed  
on cable channel 13 in Vero Beach, cable channel 27 in Indian River  
County and cable channel 25 or U-verse channel 99 in Sebastian.
