Beware of Voter Registration Mailings

Indian River County, FL – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections has been notified that two Washington, D.C. groups, The Voter Participation Center (VPC) and Center for Voter Information (CVI) will be sending residents mailings regarding voter registration.

The goal of these two groups is to reach unregistered voters. However, the data used is often outdated and inaccurate, which can lead to confusion regarding eligibility for voting.

These mail-outs often include Florida Voter Registration Applications with information pre-filled and are addressed to already registered voters, children under voting age, pets, and deceased family members.

“We have had multiple complaints from voters receiving previous mailings from these organizations,” Supervisor of Elections Leslie Swan said. “Some of the mailings were sent to deceased persons, whose family members were extremely upset.”
