SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED BY FLORIDA STATE ASSOCIATION OF SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS

Indian River County, FL --Supervisor of Elections, Leslie Rossway Swan, announces the opportunity for local college or university students to apply for a \$1,200 scholarship offered by the Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections (FSASE).

The scholarship will be awarded to a Political Science, Public Administration, Business Administration, Journalism or Mass Communication major who has completed two years of junior college or undergraduate work and is in good standing. Applicants must be enrolled or accepted as full-time students in a senior college or university in the state of Florida, which is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Each County's Supervisor will review all applications received and select one finalist to be sent to the FSASE Scholarship Committee, along with a written opinion of the applicant. The FSASE Scholarship Committee will select one winner from the finalists submitted by the Supervisors to be awarded a \$1,200 scholarship.

Completed FSASE scholarship applications, along with two letters of recommendation, must be submitted by March 18, 2013 to the Supervisor of Elections in the county in which the student is registered to vote.
