MAIL BALLOT DROP BOXES PROVIDED DURING EARLY VOTING

Indian River County, FL – Traditionally mail ballots had to be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office either in person or by mail. Thanks to a new service offered by the Indian River County Elections Office to make voting by mail ballot more convenient, voted ballots can now be delivered to any one of the three early voting sites during early voting hours.

Beginning on Saturday, March 5, 2016, the first day of early voting for the Presidential Preference Primary Election, voters are welcome to deposit their voted mail ballots into a sealed drop box. The secured drop boxes will be provided at the Sebastian City Hall Council Chambers, the Indian River County Main Library, and the Supervisor of Elections Office from March 5-12, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Drop boxes can be found inside the polling room and will be monitored by a poll worker at all times. Mail ballots from each of the drop boxes will be returned to the Elections Office daily, at the conclusion of voting.

A permanent drop box is also available on the outside of the Elections Office 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Voters may track the status of their mail ballot by visiting www.VoteIndianRiver.com and clicking "Track My Mail Ballot" on the homepage.
