### **Wednesday, October 31 is the Deadline for Ballots to be Mailed for the General Election**

**Indian River County, FL** – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters that 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, October 31 is the deadline to request a ballot to be mailed for the November 6 General Election. “The General Election ballot is two-sided and contains twelve Constitutional Amendments. Vote-by-mail ballots allow the voter to take their time to review their ballot and make informed choices concerning candidates and issues,” said Supervisor of Elections Leslie Swan.

Mail ballots may also be picked up at the Supervisor of Elections office beginning Thursday, November 1 through Monday, November 5. Mail ballot pickup and voting in the Elections Office on Election Day is only permitted in the case of an emergency.

All voted mail ballots must be received at the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day to be counted.
