**Wednesday, August 22 is the Deadline for Ballots to be Mailed
for the Primary Election**

Indian River County, FL – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters that 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 22 is the deadline to request a ballot to be mailed for the August 28 Primary Election. “Vote-by-mail ballots are a convenience, voters can vote from home,” said Supervisor of Elections Leslie Swan.

Mail ballots may also be picked up at the Supervisor of Elections Office beginning Thursday, August 23 through Monday, August 27. Mail ballot pickup and voting in the Elections Office on Election Day is only permitted in the case of an emergency.

All mail ballots must be received at the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day to be counted. Voters may track their mail ballot status online at VoteIndianRiver.com to find out when their ballot was mailed and when their voted ballot was received by the Supervisor of Elections.
