Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for November 6 General Election

Indian River County, FL- The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections has mailed 468 ballots to absent military and overseas voters on Tuesday, September 18 for the November 6, 2018 General Election. Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside of the United States. State law requires uniformed and overseas citizen's ballots be mailed at least 45 days before early voting begins.

A ballot mailing to approximately 20,000 domestic voters is tentatively scheduled for October 2. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States. Domestic ballots are required to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election.
