Elections Office to Host Election Worker Orientation Classes

Indian River County, FL – The Indian River County Supervisor of Elections will host two election worker orientation classes for the 2018 election cycle. The orientation classes will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Office on Jan. 17 and April 18 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. Classes are open to any Indian River County resident who is interested in serving at the polls on Election Day. All election workers must be registered voters in Indian River County.

The two-hour orientation class will cover all of the responsibilities and requirements that come with serving as an election worker, as well as, introducing election workers to Indian River County's new voting equipment. "We offer orientation classes each year so residents of our county have the opportunity to learn what is expected of our election workers. This job is not for everyone due to the long hours," said Supervisor of Elections, Leslie Swan.
