Indian River County, FL – Supervisor of Elections, Leslie Swan, announces that the Elections Office will reopen to the public on Tuesday, May 19, 2020. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

“Even though we have been closed to the public since March 23 due to the Coronavirus, we have continued to process requests from candidates and voters,” said Supervisor Swan. “We do look forward to seeing our voters and candidates in person again.”

The Election Office has been equipped with social distancing guidelines, stanchions, hand sanitizer, and floor spacing tape to keep everyone safe.
