Students all over Indian River County have the opportunity to vote on their favorite books with the help of the Supervisor of Elections office touch-screen voting machines and trusted staff. Every year, students in grades K-9 are given a list of books to read. At the end of the allotted time, students who have read the books have a chance to experience what it is like to vote by selecting their favorite book on the touch-screen machines! Once voting is complete, the results are printed, tabulated, and distributed to the media specialist of each school, so that he or she may announce the winner. Each child who votes receives an “I Voted” sticker, a pencil, and a signed certificate from Leslie Swan, Indian River County’s Supervisor of Elections. This program is fantastic for encouraging children to read and demonstrating what it is like to participate in an election.
