# 1. Vote-By-Mail

## Request to Vote-By-Mail

A vote-by-mail ballot request may be made in person, by mail, by email, by phone, or online via the website VoteIndianRiver.com.

Wednesday, October 31, 2018 is the last day to request a vote-bymail ballot to be mailed for the General Election.

Voted ballots must be received by the Supervisor of Elections office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.

Vote-By-Mail Ballot Drop Boxes Completed vote-by-mail ballots may also be delivered to any one of the three early voting locations during voting hours.

November 6, 2018 - Election Day Polls are open 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

### WHERE DO I VOTE?

On Election Day you must vote at your polling place. Locate your polling place online at VoteIndianRiver.com or call 772.226.3440.

It is a felony to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside.

Address changes within the state of Florida may be processed at any time, including Election Day at the polls. Voters who wait to update their address on Election Day may have a slight delay in voting and may also be directed to another polling place based on the voter's new residence address.

The Indian River County voting system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot. Please completely fill in the oval. Any other mark may not be read by the scanner.





There is a significant change in your signature or identifying "mark".

# **ID Requirement**

Florida Statute 101.043, requires voters to provide valid photo and signature I.D. to vote. If you do not have valid identification, you may vote a provisional ballot.

## Forms of Acceptable ID Include:

Florida Driver's License Florida ID Card U.S. Passport Military or Student ID Debit/Credit Card Government Issued Employee ID Concealed Weapons Permit Veterans Affairs ID Public Assistance ID Retirement or Neighborhood Association ID
