Florida is a Closed Primary State. A voter may only vote in a primary for the party in which he/she is registered. A voter registered without a party affiliation may only vote in nonpartisan races in a primary election.

Request to Vote-By-Mail
 A vote-by-mail ballot request may be made in person, by mail, by email, by phone, or online via the website at VoteIndianRiver.com.

Wednesday, August 22, 2018 is the last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot to be mailed for the Primary Election.

Voted ballots must be received by the Supervisor of Elections office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.

 Completed vote-by-mail ballots may also be delivered to any one of the three early voting locations during voting hours.

WHERE DO I VOTE?
 On Election Day you must vote at your polling place. Locate your polling place online at VoteIndianRiver.com or call 772.226.3440.

It is a felony to vote in a precinct in which you do not reside. If your address has changed, please contact the Elections Office **BEFORE** August 28th.

ID Requirement
 Section 101.043, F.S., requires voters to provide a valid photo and signature identification to vote. If you do not have valid identification, you may vote a provisional ballot.

How:
 Use a Florida Voter Registration Application.

When:
 There is a significant change in your signature or identifying "mark".

- Government Issued Employee ID
- Concealed Weapons Permit
- Veterans Affairs ID

YOUR PARTY AFFILIATION

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE (F.S. 101.021)

Only voters who are registered members of political parties may vote for their respective party's candidates in a primary election.

ALL REGISTERED VOTERS MAY VOTE FOR:

Nonpartisan Races: This includes judicial and school board races.

Constitutional Amendments and/or Local Referendum Questions

Universal Primary Contests: If all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner of the Primary Election will not face opposition in the General Election, then all registered voters may vote for any of the candidates for that office in the Primary Election.
